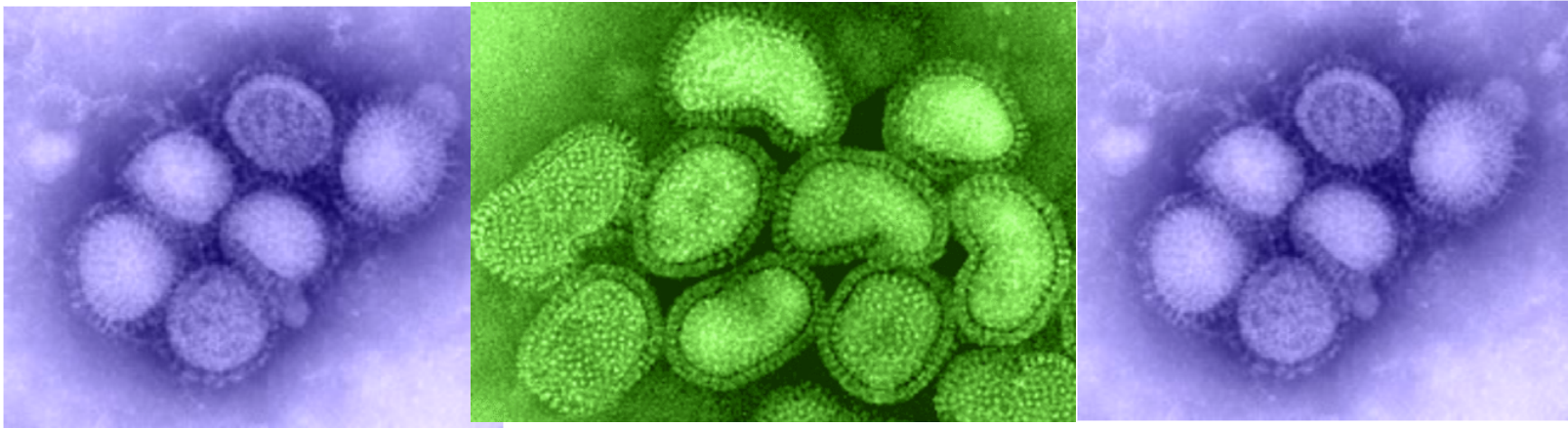

# Global Impact of Influenza H1N1 2009

- Involved more than 214 countries (confirmed cases of pandemic influenza H1N1 2009)
- At least 18,449 deaths among lab-confirmed cases (WHO August 6, 2010)

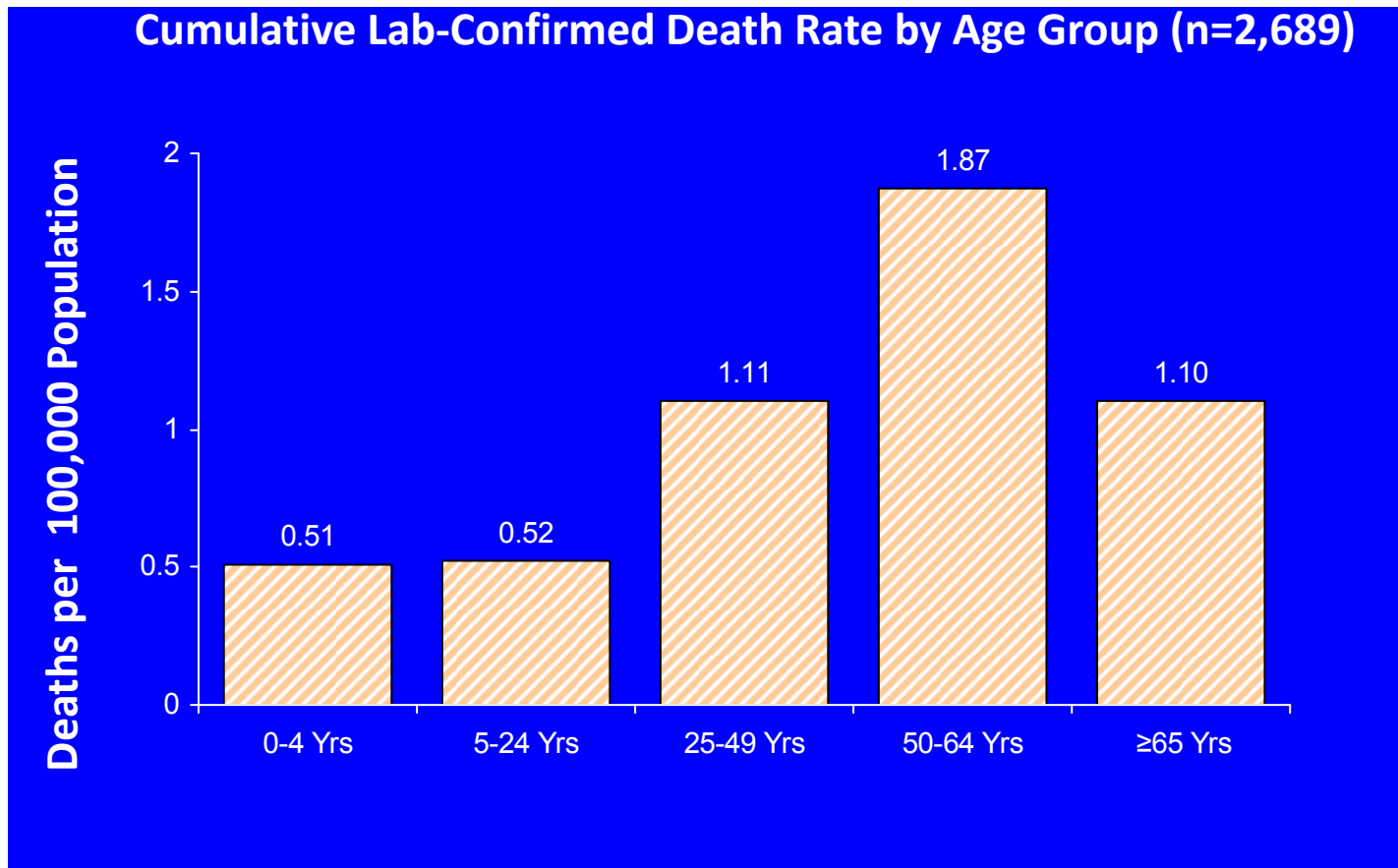
## Pandemic influenza in Thailand, 2009

- Reported cases 120,400 cases
- Incidence: 190 per 100,000 population
- Death: 231 cases
- Mortality rate: 0.36 per 100,000 population

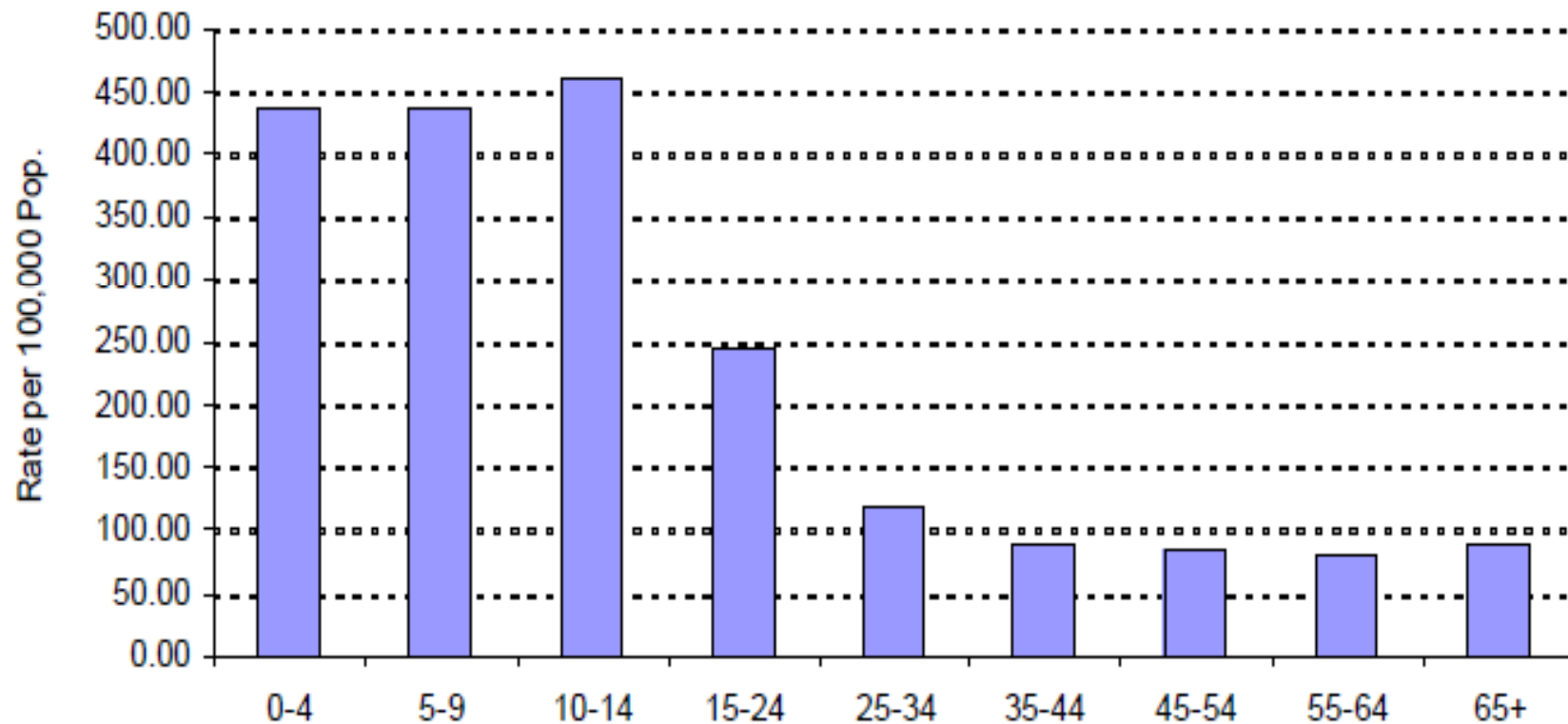
