



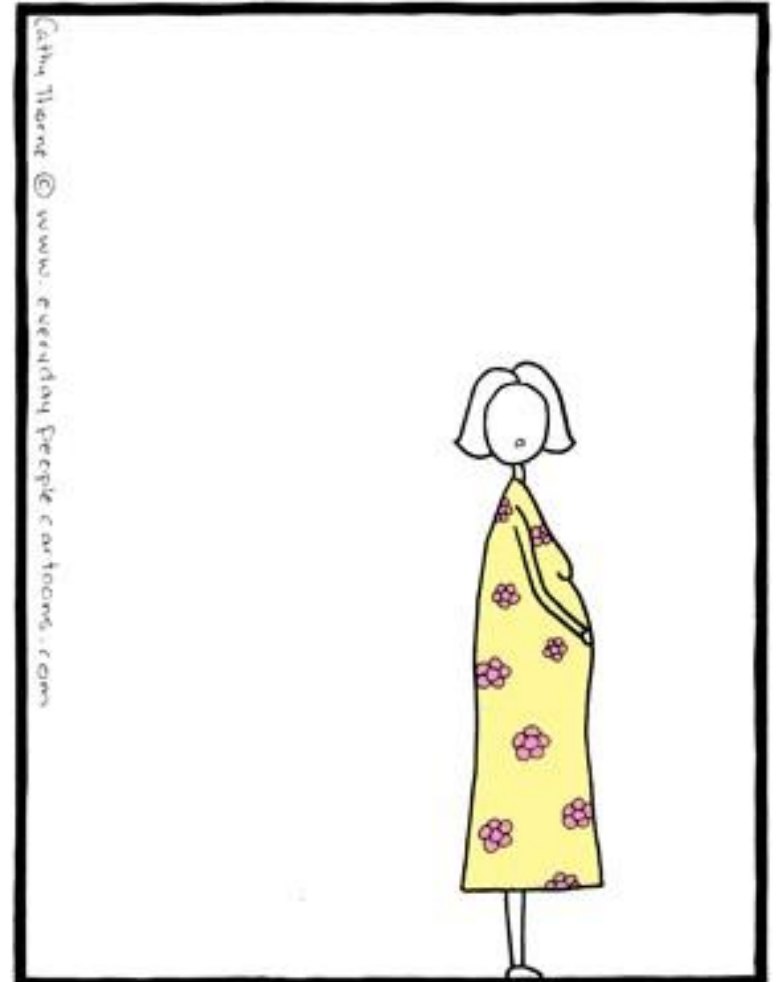

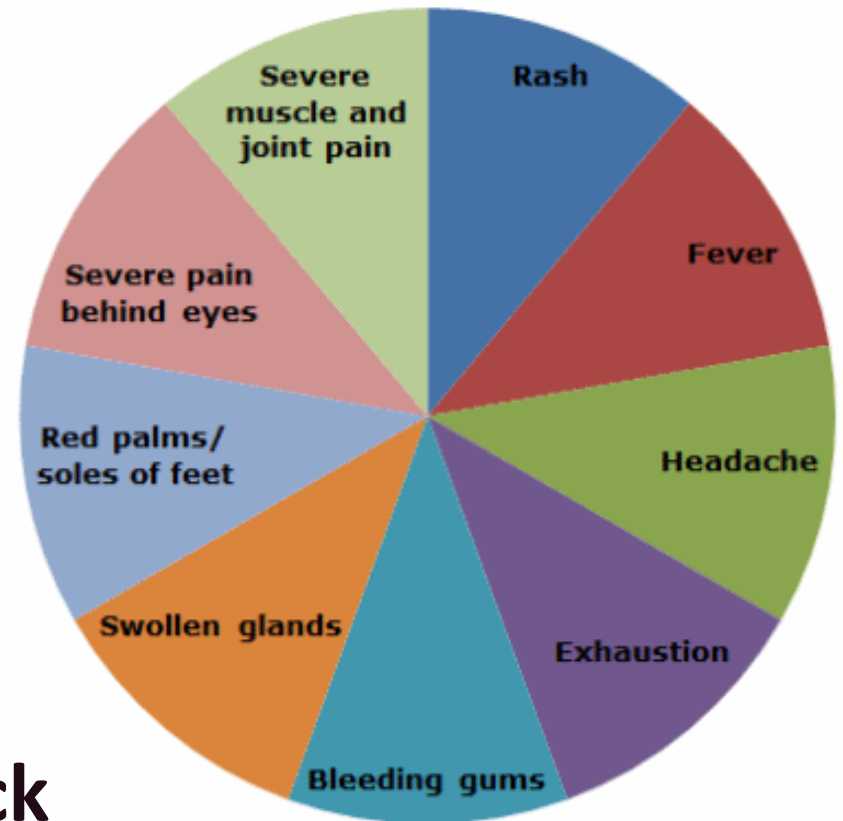
Clinical presentation

- **Not different from the non-pregnant patient**
- **Mostly diagnosed clinically**
- **Confirmed by laboratory tests : positive serology/ viral PCR studies**



Typical presentation

- Abrupt fever
- Headache
- Retro-orbital pain
- Myalgia
- Thrombocytopenia
- Some cases :
hemoconcentration,
pleural effusion, shock



Diagnosis

- **Mostly diagnosed clinically**
- **History taking :**
 - **travel to endemic area**
 - **pregnant women with fever during epidemics in endemic areas**
