#### Case

- A 1-year-old boy presents with peri-anal itching.
- Physical examinations reveal peri-anal erythema, otherwise unremarkable.





What is the diagnosis?

What is the treatment of choice?

#### Case

- Diagnosis: Enterobius vermicularis infection
- Treatment:
  - Albendazole 200 mg orally one dose
  - Repeat with the same dose 2 weeks later
  - Use 400 mg/dose in children > 2 years old
  - Mebendazole not approved in children < 2 years old</li>





# E. Vermicularis Autoinfection

### Albendazole: target adult worms
