## Update TB guideline: Treatment

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#### Case

- A 5-year-old previously healthy boy, presented with persistent pneumonia
- History of contact TB from his grandmother 1 year PTA



- TST = 17 mm
- Gastric aspiration
  - AFB: negative x 3 days
  - Xpert MTB/RIF: negative
  - Culture for TB: pending

### Which regimens are the appropriate treatment?

A. 2HRZE/4HR (6 months)

B. 2HRZE/2HR (4 months)

C. 2HPZM/2HPM (4months)

P=rifapentine, M=moxifloxacin


