#### Vaccination for travelers

#### Need consideration about

- Travelers: health, age, underlying dz., vaccine
- Risk of destination (itinerary, activity, season, rural/urban, outbreak, epidemics, endemic dz.)
- Vaccine: benefit, risk of AE and multiple vaccines given
- Duration before departure
  - Need other safety measures



#### Vaccination for travelers

- Routine vaccination
  - Need to be updated
- Recommended vaccination
  - Selective use for travelers
- Required vaccination
  - Need certificate: Yellow fever vaccine, Meningococcal vaccine for Hajj/Umrah pilgrims



## Yellow Fever (YF)

- YF virus, Flavivirus
- Vector: primarily Aedes or Haemagogus spp.
- Main reservoirs of the virus: Nonhuman and human primates
- Transmission cycles: sylvatic (jungle), and urban.
